Planning for the New Zealand International Bugatti Rally in 2014 is well advanced.

Hotels and activities have been booked and deposits paid. The route has been checked, in some parts, several times, and the organising team have planned an event that will surprise and delight you.

We start in New Zealand's largest city, Auckland, and after a day touring north of that city, head south to Lake Taupo.

We will visit the set of Hobbiton where New Zealander, Sir Peter Jackson, produced the Lord of the Rings epics. Rotorua will be remembered for the spectacular geysers and boiling mud pools and at Waitomo we will visit the fabulous glow worm caves, have a Kiwi house tour at Otorohanga and back at the Taupo Hilton that night. We will take a thrilling ride up the Shotover River, scene of rich gold finds last century, in a jet boat. We will explore the old gold diggings and towns and there will be free time to chose one of the many other activitioes available in the area.

From Queenstown we head north with a visit to the newly opened Highlands Motor Sport Park, lunch at Northwood Station and then on to Mt. Cook, New Zealand's highest mountain, where we will overnight at the Hermitage.

Our final motoring day takes us through to Christchurch. The cars will be prepared and packed for shipping, the final dinner will take place at the Antarctic Centre, and another great Bugatti event will be over.
